The Indemnity (No. 2) Act, 1970

Short title.

[22nd October, 1970.]

Date of com-
mencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. No action or other legal proceeding whatsoever whether civil or criminal shall be instituted in any Court of Law for or on account of, or in respect of any act, matter or thing done whether within Sierra Leone or without, during the period extending from the 13th of September to 19th of October, 1970, if done in good faith and done or purported to be done in the execution of his duty or in the public interest—

(a) by any member of the Royal Sierra Leone Military Forces or of the Sierra Leone Police force; or

(b) by any Minister of Government; or

(c) by any body or person acting directly or indirectly under the authority of—

(i) any Minister of Government; or

(ii) any member of the Royal Sierra Leone Military Forces; or

(iii) any member of the Sierra Leone Police Force,
and if any proceeding has been instituted whether before or after the commencement of this Act, it shall be discharged and made void:

Provided that the provisions of this section shall in no way affect the institution or prosecution of proceedings on behalf of Her Majesty or any Government Department or any proceedings instituted by way of Petition of Right.

Passed in the House of Representatives this 21st day of October, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy.
