THE IMPOSITION OF CURFEW DECREE, 1992

(N.P.R.C. Decree No. 3 of 1992)

THE IMPOSITION OF CURFEW ORDER, 1992

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 2 of the Imposition of Curfew Decree, 1992, the National Provisional Ruling Council hereby makes the following Order—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 30th day of April, 1992 and shall apply throughout Sierra Leone. Commencement and Application.

2. As from the 30th day of April, 1992 to the morning of the 2nd day of May, 1992, no person shall be out of doors between the hours of 6 p.m. and 6 a.m. except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Inspector-General of Police or any officer deputed by him in that behalf. Curfew from 30th April, to 2nd May, 1992.

3. As from the evening of the 2nd day of May, 1992 to the morning of the 4th day of May, 1992, no person shall be out of doors between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. except with a written permit prescribed in paragraph 2. Curfew from 2nd May to 4th May, 1992.

4. As from the 4th day of May, 1992, no person shall be out of doors between the hours of 12 p.m. each day and 6 a.m. the following day except with the written permit prescribed in paragraph 2. Curfew from 4th May, 1992.
