**THE CUSTOMS ACT**  
(Cap. 271)

THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATION, 1979

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 248 of the Customs Act, the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. Paragraphs (2) and (3) of Regulations 17 of the Customs Regulation are hereby revoked and replaced by the following new paragraphs—

“(2) An Invoice Entry Fee of 9½% of the C.I.F. value of all imported goods except those specifically exempted by the Minister of Finance shall be collected by the Comptroller of Customs at the time of Entry of the goods:

Provided that an Invoice Entry Fee of 5% shall be collected on goods originating in Countries belonging to the Economic Community of West African States.

(3) An Invoice Entry Fee of 9½% of the C.I.F. value of all imported goods except those specifically exempted by the Minister of Finance shall be collected by the Comptroller of Customs at the time of Entry of the goods:

Provided that an Invoice Licence Fee of 5% shall be collected on goods originating in Countries belonging to the Economic Community of West African States.”
