**The Public Order (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1973**

[20th September, 1973.]

Short title.  
Date of

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Section 12 of the Public Order Act, 1965 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section 12—

"Riotous  
conduct.

12. A person commits an offence who—

(a) in any public way or place, or, in any house, yard or garden or other place open to the public view, or within public hearing, or

- (b) in any court or Police Station, or in any lock-up near a court-room, or
- (c) in any theatre, concert hall, lecture room or other place of public entertainment or instruction of whatever kind,

behaves in any riotous, indecent, insulting, or disorderly manner, and shall, on conviction thereof, be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred leones or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding eighteen months or to both such fine and imprisonment”.

Passed in Parliament this *4th* day of *September*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
