**An Ordinance to Amend the Post Office Ordinance** Cap. 176.

[11th May, 1961.] Date of  
commence-  
ment.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Legislature of Sierra Leone, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1961.

2. Section 19 of the Post Office Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment  
by the insertion immediately after paragraph (e) thereof of the of section 19  
following paragraph (f)— of Cap. 176.

“(f) Postal matter relating only to statutory returns required by the Director of Education sent to him by any Local Education Authority, Government school or school subsidised from Government funds and franked by the signature of the Chairman of such authority, manager or headmaster of such school, as the case may be, or some other persons authorised by them.”.
