The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Interim Council) Proclamation (Amendment) Decree, 1968 Short title.

[23rd April, 1968.] Date of commencement.

WHEREAS the National Interim Council is unshaken in its resolve to hand over the Administration of Sierra Leone to a Civilian Government:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable as an early step towards that end that the office of Governor-General, hitherto suspended by the National Reformation Council, should be revived:

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Interim Council) Proclamation 1968", published in the *Gazette* on the 19th day of April 1968 the National Interim Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree:—

Repeal and replacement of para. 2 of P.N. 21 of 1968.

1. Paragraph 2 of the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Interim Council) Proclamation 1968 published in the *Gazette* on the 19th of April 1968, hereinafter referred to as the Proclamation, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new paragraph—

"Suspension of certain provisions of the Constitution, P.N. 78 of 1961.

2. All the provisions of the Constitution of Sierra Leone 1961 which came into operation on the 27th day of April, 1961 other than those provisions relating to the office and functions of the Governor-General and which are inconsistent with this Proclamation or any Decree made hereunder shall be deemed to have been suspended with effect from the 18th day of April, 1968."

Amendment of paragraph 6 of P.N. 21 of 1968.

2. Paragraph 6 of the Proclamation is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "Governor-General," in the second line thereof.
