The Southern Rhodesia (Sanctions) Act, 1968

Short title.

[25th July, 1968.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. In this Act, the expression—

Definition.

“goods of Southern Rhodesian origin” means goods or any part thereof which are grown, produced or manufactured in Southern Rhodesia:

“Minister” means the Minister charged with responsibility for matters relating to Trade and Industry.

Application. 2. The provisions of this Act shall not apply to the importation of welfare material for the use of seafarers on foreign ships engaged in international trade in accordance with the Customs Convention concerning welfare material for seafarers signed in Brussels on the 1st day of December, 1964.

Southern Rhodesian goods not to be imported 3. No goods of Southern Rhodesian origin shall be imported into Sierra Leone:

Provided that the restriction imposed by this section shall not apply to the personal effects of travellers arriving in Sierra Leone.

Goods consigned from Southern Rhodesia not to be imported. 4. No goods of any origin consigned to Sierra Leone from Southern Rhodesia otherwise than by way of transit from another country shall be imported into Sierra Leone.

Goods not to be exported to Southern Rhodesia. 5. No goods exported or re-exported from Sierra Leone shall be consigned either directly or indirectly to Southern Rhodesia otherwise than by way of transit to another country.

Minister may grant licences in special cases. 6. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 3, 4 and 5, where the Minister is satisfied that for the avoidance of personal hardship it is necessary to import or export certain goods otherwise than for trade purposes, he may grant a licence in writing to import, export or consign a specific quantity of such goods subject to any such conditions and restrictions as he shall see fit to impose.

(2) The provisions of this section shall cease to have effect after the expiration of one month from the coming into operation of this Act.

White Southern Rhodesians not to enter or remain in Sierra Leone. 7. Except with the written permission of the Minister no citizen of Southern Rhodesia who is entitled in Southern Rhodesia to the rights and privileges granted exclusively to the members of the white races shall enter or remain in Sierra Leone:

Provided that any such persons who are in Sierra Leone at the commencement of this Act may remain therein for a period not exceeding three months for the purposes of winding up their affairs.

Penalty. 8. Any person contravening any of the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred leones or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

9. The Southern Rhodesia (Sanctions) Decree, 1967 is hereby repealed.
