Short title.

THE FORESTRY (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 19 of the Forestry Act, the President acting in accordance with the advice of Cabinet and with the approval of Parliament hereby makes the following order:—

1. Schedule A to the Forestry Order is hereby revoked and replaced by the following schedule—

SCHEDULE A

MAJOR FOREST PRODUCE

The fees and royalties payable in respect of the species classified in the first column and listed by their scientific and vernacular names in the second and third columns shall be at the rates per cubic foot Hoppus measured under bark shown for each class, and the minimum girths in feet shall be those shown in the fourth column of Table I below—

Provided that where application is made to take timber for conversion by pitsawing only, the Chief Conservator or his representative may authorise that the fees and royalties for species of which the classes, names and girth limits are enumerated in columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Table I above, shall be at the rates per tree shown in Table II below.
