**The Law Reform Commission (Amendment)
Act, 1981**

Short title.

**Being an Act to amend the Law Reform Commission Act 1975 in
order to extend the qualifications for appointment to the Law Reform
Commission**

[2nd October, 1975.] Date of com-
mencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in
this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the
2nd day of October, 1975. commencement.

Repeal and
replacement
of Section 1
(3) of Act
No. 12 of
1975.

2. Subsection (3) of Section 1 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new sub-section—

“(3) Any person appointed to be Commissioner shall be a Sierra Leonean who appears to the President, upon the recommendation of the Attorney-General, to be suitably qualified:

- (a) by the holding of judicial office, or
- (b) by having not less than seven years experience either as a barrister or solicitor, or
- (c) as a teacher of law in a University, or
- (d) by reason of his special qualifications, training or experience in civic or other matters.”

Passed in Parliament this 8th day of April, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-one.
