The Ports Act, 1964 (Amendment) Decree, 1968

Short title.

[25th January, 1968.] Date of

PURSUANT to the Proclamation entitled "Administration of Sierra Leone (National Reformation Council) Proclamation, 1967" published in the *Gazette* on the 25th of March, 1967, the National Reformation Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree:—

1. Section 2 of the Ports Act, 1964 is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition of "Minister" and the insertion in its proper alphabetical place of the following new definition—

“N.R.C. Representative” means the Member of the National Reformation Council charged with responsibility for matters relating to Works, Transport and Communications;

2. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 5 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

“Constitu-
tion of the
Authority.

5. (1) The Authority shall consist of—

- (a) a Chairman, who shall not be a Government Officer, to be appointed by the N.R.C. Representative;
- (b) two representatives of the Sierra Leone Chamber of Commerce one of whom shall be a Sierra Leone Citizen, to be appointed by the N.R.C. Representative;
- (c) two representatives of the shipping companies to be appointed by the N.R.C. Representative on the recommendation of the shipping companies;
- (d) one representative of the Workers' Union to be appointed by the N.R.C. Representative on the recommendation of the Workers' Union;
- (e) the Establishment Secretary or his representative;
- (f) a representative of the Department of Finance;
- (h) a representative of the Department of Works, Transport and Communications;

(2) With the exception of the representatives of the Chamber of Commerce and the shipping companies who may not be citizens of Sierra Leone, the Chairman and all the other members of the Authority shall be citizens of Sierra Leone and shall hold office subject to such conditions as the N.R.C. Representative may determine.”.

3. The expression “the Minister” shall be replaced by the expression “the N.R.C. Representative” whenever the first expression occurs in the principal Act.
