**THE CIVIL AVIATION ACT, 1966**  
(Act No. 33 of 1966)

**THE AIRPORT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1985**

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Communications by Section 3 of the Civil Aviation Act, 1966 (Act No. 33 of 1966) the following Regulations are hereby made—

1. The Airport Regulations 1980 (P.N. No. 25 of 1980) in these Regulations referred to as the "principal Regulations" are hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (k) of regulation 2 thereof, of the following new paragraph—

"(k) smoke or bring any naked light in or into—

  - (i) any place where any such act is prohibited by notice; or
  - (ii) any place within fifty feet of any airport or a store of liquid fuel, or explosives."
2. The principal Regulations are hereby further amended by the substitution for regulation 6 thereof of the following new regulation—

"Penalties. 6. Any person who—

  - (a) contravenes any of the provisions of Regulation 2, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two thousand leones or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding two years or both;
  - (b) contravenes any of the provisions of regulation 3 or paragraph (a) of Regulation 5, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand leones or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding twelve months or both;

- (c) contravenes any of the provisions of Regulation 4, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding two hundred leones or a term of imprisonment not exceeding six months or both;
- (d) contravenes any of the provisions of Regulation 5 other than paragraph (n) thereof, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred leones or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding three months or both."
