The Coroners (Amendment) Act, 1981

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Coroners Act and to increase the fees payable to Deputy Coroners for every completed inquest

[1st July, 1981] Date of Commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1981. Commencement.

2. Section 5 of the Coroners Act is hereby amended by the substitution in the first and second lines thereof for the words "ten leones" of the words twenty leones".
