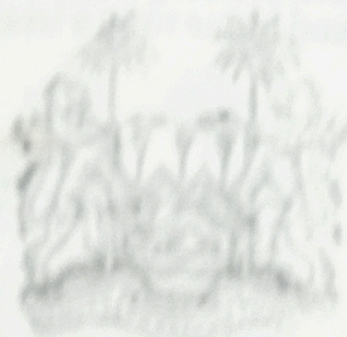

The Constitution of Sierra Leone (Amendment)
Act, 1991

Short title.

Being an Act to amend the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1978

Date of
Commence-
ment.

Be it enacted by the President and Members of Parliament in
this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on
the 20th day of January, 1990.

Commence-
ment.

Repeal and replacement of section 33 of Act No. 12 of 1978.

2. Section 33 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1978 is repealed and replaced by the following new section—

“Registration of voters.

33. Every citizen of Sierra Leone being eighteen years of age and above, and of sound mind, shall have the right to vote; and accordingly shall be entitled to be registered as a voter for the purposes of public elections.”
