**The Freetown Municipality Act (Amendment)  
Decree, 1968** Short title.

[1st July, 1967.] Date of  
commence-  
ment.

PURSUANT to the Proclamation entitled "Administration of Sierra Leone (National Reformation Council) Proclamation, 1967", published in the *Gazette* on the 25th of March, 1967, the National Reformation Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree:—

1. This Decree shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1967. Commence-

2. Subsection (3) of section 103 of the Freetown Municipality Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(3) No rates shall be payable in respect of premises which are owned by a foreign state for any of the following purposes, that is to say—

- (a) a diplomatic mission;
- (b) a consular office;
- (c) a residence for a diplomatic or consular officer or employee;
- (d) any other purpose, to which the National Reformation Council does not object, arising out of the operation of the diplomatic or consular establishment of such foreign state:

Provided that this subsection shall only apply where the National Reformation Council certifies that reciprocal privileges are enjoyed by Sierra Leone diplomatic or consular establishments in the territories of such foreign states.”.
