**The Legal Practitioners (Amendment) Act, 1969**

Short title.

**Being an Act to amend the Legal Practitioners Act.**

[6th January, 1966.]

Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 6th day of January, 1966. Commencement.

Repeal and  
replacement  
of section 3  
of Cap. 11.

2. The Legal Practitioners Act is hereby amended by inserting immediately after section 3 thereof the following new section—

“ 3A (1) The Chief Justice may, if he thinks fit, at any time order the Master and Registrar to replace on the Roll of Court of the Supreme Court the name of any Legal Practitioner whose name has been struck off the said Roll of Court.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 23 of the Legal Practitioners (Disciplinary Committee) Act, 1965 or any other provision of this Act or any other enactment, an order of the Chief Justice under subsection (1) hereof that the name of any Legal Practitioner be replaced on the Roll of the Supreme Court shall, for all purposes be deemed to be an admission of such Legal Practitioner to practise as a Legal Practitioner in Sierra Leone and shall entitle him to practise in Sierra Leone as a Legal Practitioner.”.

Passed in the House of Representatives this 7th day of *January*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.
