The Advisory Council (Establishment) Decree, 1992 Short title.

[10th September, 1992] Date of

PURSUANT to the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Provisional Ruling Council) Proclamation, 1992", published in the *Gazette* on the 4th day of May, 1992 as Public Notice No. 20 of 1992, the National Provisional Ruling Council hereby makes and issues the following Decree—

1. (1) There is hereby established a Council to be called the ADVISORY COUNCIL which shall consist of ~~fifteen~~ members.

(2) Members of the Advisory Council shall not be paid any salary but shall be entitled to allowances as the National Provisional Ruling Council shall approve.

Functions of  
Advisory  
Council.

2. The functions of the Advisory Council shall include—
- (a) working out the modalities for the return to multi-party democracy with a view to ensuring a broader and equitable participation of the citizenry in the democratization process and reflecting the views and aspirations of the people;
  - (b) advising and making recommendations to the National Provisional Ruling Council on any issue of national importance;
  - (c) such other functions as the National Provisional Ruling Council may from time to time specify in writing.

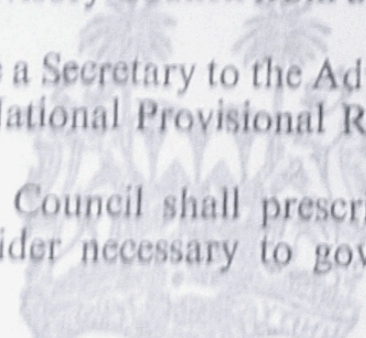
3. There shall be a Chairman and Vice-Chairman respectively of the Advisory Council, who shall be elected by majority vote at the first meeting of the Advisory Council from among its members.

Appointment  
of Secretary.

4. There shall be a Secretary to the Advisory Council who shall be appointed by the National Provisional Ruling Council.

5. The Advisory Council shall prescribe such Rules of Procedure as it may consider necessary to govern the conduct of its meetings.
