**The Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1973**

Short title.

[20th September, 1973.]

Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Subsection (1) of section 7 of the Pensions Act (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act") is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

Amendment of section 7 of Cap. 173.

"(1) on or after attaining the age of fifty years subject (unless the officer has attained the age of fifty-five years) to six months' notice in writing of his desire to retire having been given by the officer to the President through the Establishment Secretary, unless the President sees fit to waive this condition;".

Repeal and  
replacement  
of section 9  
of Cap. 173

2. Section 9 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following—

“Compulsory retirement. 9. The President may require any officer to retire from the public service of Sierra Leone at any time after attaining the age of fifty years subject to six months’ notice in writing of such requirement being given to the officer.”.

Passed in Parliament this 3rd day of *September*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
