**THE FISHERIES ACT**  
**(Cap. 195)**

**THE (ROYALTY FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1983**      Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 13 of the Fisheries Act, (Cap 195) the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1983.      Commencement.

2. The Second Schedule to the Fisheries (Royalty Fees) Regulations, 1976 (P.N. No. 10 of 1976) is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new Schedule—      Replacement of Second Schedule to P.N. No. 10 of 1976.

**“SECOND SCHEDULE**

**ROYALTY FEES PAYABLE FOR FISH OR SHELL FISH BY A MOTOR FISHING VESSEL**

1. Royalty Fees to be paid by local vessels for taking fish or shell fish within the territorial waters:—

(a) all local vessels taking fish within the territorial waters shall pay per ton on the gross registered tonnage—Le6.00 p.a.

(b) all local vessels taking shell fish within the territorial waters shall pay per ton on the gross registered tonnage—Le20.00 p.a.

2. Royalty Fees to be paid by foreign vessels taking fish or shell fish within the territorial waters:—

- (a) all foreign vessels taking fish within the territorial waters shall pay per ton on the gross registered tonnage—Le90.00 p.a.
- (b) all foreign vessels taking shell fish within the territorial waters shall pay per ton on the gross registered tonnage—Le150.00 p.a.”.
