THE CUSTOMS ACT
(*Cap. 271*)

THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1981

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 248 of the Customs Act, the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 1981. Commencement.
2. The proviso to paragraph (3) of Regulation 17 of the Customs Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new proviso— Amendment of Regulation 17 (3) of Vol. VIII Page 2062.

“ Provided that an Import Licence Fee of 5% shall be collected on goods originating in countries belonging to the Economic Community of West African States; Raw materials, plants and machinery imported by manufacturers of locally produced goods, packages, including materials and parts for the manufacture thereof necessary for the packing or distribution of any product produced, manufactured, or processed in Sierra Leone imported exclusively for such purpose and accepted as such by the Comptroller.”
