The Justices of Appeal (Appointment) Act, 1966

Short title.

Being an Act to Prescribe the number of Judges who may be appointed under Paragraph (C) of Subsection (2) of Section 79 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone

[18th August, 1966.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Interpreta-
tion.

1. In this Act the expression "Justice of Appeal" means one of the judges of the Court of Appeal, the number of whom may be prescribed by Parliament under paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 79 of the Constitution.

2. The number of Justices of Appeal shall be any number not exceeding five.

3. The Justices of Appeal Act, 1961, is hereby repealed.
