WHEREAS by Sections 74 and 75 of the Constitution it is provided that a Session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Sierra Leone and shall commence at such time as the President may by Proclamation appoint and that the President may at any time prorogue Parliament:

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIIKA STEVENS, President, Supreme Head of State, Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces of Sierra Leone, do by this my Proclamation prorogue Parliament with effect from the 13th day of June, 1985 and DO HEREBY FURTHER appoint and appoint that a Session of Parliament shall be held at Parliament Building, Tower Hill, commencing on Friday, the 14th day of June, 1985 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.
