PROCLAMATION

**UNDER SECTION 45 OF THE PUBLIC ORDER ACT, 1965
(P.N. No. 33 of 1981)**

THE STATE OF EMERGENCY (DETENTION) (NO. 3) ORDER, 1982 Short title.

WHEREAS the President has deemed it fit and necessary for the purpose of dealing with the State of Emergency declared by Proclamation of the 10th day of December, 1981 that the person named in the Schedule hereto be detained to prevent him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and order: P.N. No. 33 of 1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Section 45 of the Public Order Act, 1965 the President hereby makes the following Order:— Act No. 46 of 1965.

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 3rd day of February, 1982. Commencement.

2. The person named in the Schedule hereto shall be detained in such place or places and for such period as the President shall determine. Certain person to be detained.
