## *THE POST OFFICE ACT* *(Cap. 160)*

### THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1981

Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23 of the Post Office Act, the Director-General of Posts and Telecommunications hereby makes the following Rules:—

1. These Rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of May, 1979. Commencement.

2. Rules 121 and 124 of the Post Office Rules, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) are hereby revoked and replaced by the following new Rules— Amendment of Vol. VII Pages 1232-1233.

“Renting of boxes and bags.

121. (1) Private boxes and bags may be rented by private individuals, companies and institutions whose applications are approved by the Director-General. Correspondence consisting of ordinary letters, postcards and printed papers may be placed in such private boxes and bags.

Extra Large Boxes	...	Le40.00	per annum

New locks.

124. A new lock shall be fixed to a box upon the pre-payment by the holder of the sum of Le6.00 and Le10.00 for iron and brass locks respectively.”.

3. The principal Rules are hereby amended by the insertion immediately after rule 3 thereof of the following new Rule—

“Power to impose surcharge. 3A. It shall be lawful for the Director-General to impose a surcharge of 15 per cent in addition to all postage rates, in pre-payment of postage.”.
