THE IMPOSITION OF CURFEW DECREE, 1992
(N.P.R.C. DECREE NO. 3 OF 1992)

THE IMPOSITION OF CURFEW ORDER, 1996

Short title.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon it by section 2 of the Imposition of Curfew Decree, 1992, the National Provisional Ruling Council hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th January, 1996, and shall apply throughout Sierra Leone.

Commence-
ment.

2. (1) As from the date of commencement of this order, a curfew is imposed starting from seven o'clock in the afternoon and ending at six o'clock of the next morning.

Date and
hours of
curfew.

(2) With effect from the 17th January, 1996, the curfew shall start from midnight of each day and end at six o'clock of the next morning.

3. During the hours of the curfew imposed by paragraph 2, no person shall be out of doors except under the authority of a written permission granted by the Inspector-General of Police or any officer not below the rank of Superintendent of Police deputed by him in that behalf.
