The Constitution (Amendment) (No. 3) Act, 1973.

Short title.

[31st December, 1973.]

Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Subsection (1) of section 16 of the Constitution is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

Repeal and replacement of subsection (1) of section 16 of Act No. 6 of 1971.

“(1) There shall be a Supreme Head of State, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces and Grand Commander of the Order of the Republic, who shall be known as the President of Sierra Leone and who is referred to in this

Constitution as the President. He shall embody the national unity and ensure the continuance of the State. As guardian of the Constitution he shall be the guarantor of national independence, of the integrity of the Territory, of respect for Treaties and International Agreements; he shall be the Fountain Head of Justice, and the Fountain of Honour.”.

Passed in Parliament this *18th* day of *December*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
