THE ADMINISTRATION OF SIERRA LEONE (NATIONAL  
PROVISIONAL RULING COUNCIL) PROCLAMATION, 1992  
(P.N. No. 20 of 1992)

THE PUBLIC EMERGENCY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1993 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (5) of section 29 of the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1991 as adapted by paragraph 5 of the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Provisional Ruling Council) Proclamation, 1992", the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following regulations:—

1. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th day of April, 1993. Commence-  
ment.
2. The Public Emergency Regulations, 1992 are amended by— Amendment  
of P.N. No.  
25 of 1992.
  - (a) revoking regulations 12 and 16, and
  - (b) revoking and replacing regulation 17 by the following new regulation:—

"Making  
false reports.

17. (1) Any person who causes any wasteful employment of the police or a member of the armed forces by knowingly making to any person a false report—

- (a) which tends to show that—
  - (i) an offence has been committed; or
  - (ii) such person has information which is relevant to any inquiry; or
- (b) which gives rise to apprehension for the safety of any person or property,

commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred thousand leones or to imprisonment for a term of not more than five years or to both such fine and imprisonment.

(2) No proceedings shall be instituted for an offence under sub-regulation (1) except by or with the consent of the Attorney General or the Director of Public Prosecutions."
