An Act to Amend the Customs Tariff Act

Cap. 272.

[1st January, 1962.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Tariff Short title (Amendment) Act, 1962 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1962. and commencement.

Amendment
of section 5
of Cap. 272.

2. Sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Customs Tariff Act is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and buying or Head Office commission at a rate not exceeding five *per centum* of that part of the value on which commission is customarily calculated which is shown to the satisfaction of the Comptroller to be an expense incurred by the supplier or exporter in the country whence the goods were imported" beginning in the sixth and ending in the eleventh lines thereof.

Passed in the House of Representatives this *11th* day of *January*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
