The Non-Citizens (Registration, Immigration and Expulsion) (Amendment) Act, 1968 Short title.

[25th July, 1968.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the repeal and replacement of the definition of "valid passport" by the following new definition—

Amendment of Section 2 of Act No. 14 of 1965.

“valid passport” means a passport referring to the person producing the same, furnished with the photograph of such person and issued to him by or on behalf of the country of which he is a subject or a citizen and for a period which, according to the laws of that country, has not expired, except that—

- (i) in respect of subjects or citizens of such states as may be specified by the Prime Minister by Order published in the *Gazette* a valid passport shall include any other similar document issued by a competent passport control authority establishing both the nationality and identity of the persons to whom it refers, to the satisfaction of an Immigration Officer;
- (ii) in respect of officers and servants of the United Nations or any of its specialised agencies a valid passport shall include a *laissez passer* or other similar document issued by the United Nations establishing the identity of the person to whom it refers, to the satisfaction of an Immigration Officer.”.

2. Subsection (1) of section 6 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(1) Every non-citizen belonging to a class or classes prescribed by the Prime Minister and residing or being in Sierra Leone shall within such time in each year as may be prescribed, register at such place and pay such registration fee as shall be prescribed.”.
