**THE CONTROL OF GOODS (DECLARATION OF CONTROLLED GOODS) Short title.
ORDER, 1983**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 2 of the Control of Goods Act, 1962, the President acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 20th day of January, 1983. Commencement.
2. The goods described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby declared to be controlled goods within the meaning of the Control of Goods Act, 1962 (No. 6 of 1962). Declaration of controlled goods.

non-ferrous metal, not otherwise specified herein, which has not first been offered to the Sierra Leone Railway and is supported accordingly by a certificate that the metal is not required by the Railway;

cast iron scrap metal including engine blocks which are required by the Railway
