THE CUSTOMS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1993

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 248 of the Customs Act as adapted by paragraph 5 of the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Provisional Ruling Council) Proclamation, 1992", the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following regulations—

2. Regulation 11 of the Customs Regulations is amended by deleting the scale of fees set out therein and substituting therefor the following new scale—

“Provided that when, for the proper performance
of any special services, the Comptroller shall deem it
necessary to provide the whole time services of an offi-
cer the person requiring such special services shall pay
to the Comptroller such sum not exceeding ten thou-
sand leones for each month during which such special
services are required:

Provided further that when more than one officer
is deemed to be required as aforesaid the person requir-
ing such special services shall pay a further sum not
exceeding eight thousand leones a month in respect of
each such further officer directed as aforesaid.”
