The 1991/92 Appropriation Act, 1991

Short title.

Being an Act to provide for the Service of Sierra Leone for the year 1991/92

[1st July, 1991] Date of Commencement.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for the Service of Sierra Leone for the year 1991/92:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1991.

2. The sum of twenty-seven billion, three hundred and thirty-eight million leones shall be and is hereby granted to His Excellency the President for and during the year 1991/92 and the same shall be applied and expended in the manner herein described and for the several services set forth in the Schedule.

3. The said sum of twenty-seven billion, three hundred and thirty-eight million leones shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Fund for the year 1991/92 and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin and commence on and immediately after the first day of July, 1991.

4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required from time to time upon the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance to pay out of the Consolidated Fund for the several services specified in the Schedule the sum of twenty-seven billion, three hundred and thirty-eight million leones which shall come in course of payment during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1992.

5. The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorised in section 2 shall not exceed in the gross the sum of twenty-seven billion, three hundred and thirty-eight million leones from the first day of July, 1991 inclusive and any balances remaining unissued at the end of June, 1992 shall lapse and not be available for making payments in the following year.
