PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 77 of the Constitution and by Section 6 of the Electoral Provisions Act, 1962, that a General Election of Members of Parliament shall be held at such time not later than the ninetieth day after the dissolution of Parliament or such earlier day as the President may by Proclamation appoint:

AND WHEREAS I am advised that it is expedient that a General Election be held for the election of Paramount Chief Members of Parliament and Ordinary Members on the Twenty-ninth day of April, 1982 for Paramount Chief Members and on the Thirtieth day of April, 1982 for Ordinary Members respectively:

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIAKA PROBYN STEVENS, President of the Republic of Sierra Leone, Supreme Head of State, Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces, Fountain Head of Unity, Honour, Freedom and Justice, DO HEREBY Proclaim, that a General Election of the Members of Parliament preceded by a primary election on the 5th of April, 1982, shall be held on the following dates:

Paramount Chief Members	—	29th day of April, 1982
Ordinary Members	—	30th day of April, 1982

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Sierra Leone at the State House, Freetown, in the Western Area of the Republic this 1st day of April in the year of Our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-two.
