**THE COMPANIES ACT**  
(Cap. 249)

Short title. THE COMPANIES (AMENDMENT OF EIGHTH SCHEDULE) RULES, 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 317 of the Companies Act, the Minister of Finance hereby makes the following Rules:—

**"EIGHTH SCHEDULE**

**TABLE OF FEES TO BE PAID TO THE REGISTRAR**

**1— BY A COMPANY HAVING A SHARE CAPITAL**

	<i>Leones</i>
1. For registration of a company whose nominal share capital does not exceed Le4,000	... 50,000.00

For registration of a company whose nominal share capital exceeds Le4,000.00 the following fees, regulated according to the amount of nominal share capital (that is to say):—

For every Le2,000 of nominal share capital of part of Le2,000, up to Le10,000	... 100,000.00

For every Le2,000 of nominal share capital of part of Le3,000 after the first Le10,000, up to Le200,000 ... 500,000.00

For every Le2,000 of nominal share capital or part of Le2,000, after the first Le200,000 ... 200,000.00

For registration of any increase of capital made after the first registration of the Company, the fees per Le2,000, or part of Le2,000, as part of Le2,000, as would have been payable if the increased share capital had formed part of the original share capital at the time of registration.

For registering any document required or authorised to be registered or required by this Act to be delivered, sent or forwarded to the Registrar other than the memorandum or the abstract required to be delivered to the Registrar by a receiver or manager or the statement required to be sent or forwarded to the Registrar other than the memorandum or the abstract required to be delivered to the Registrar by a receiver or manager or the statement required to be sent to the Registrar by the liquidator in a winding up in Sierra Leone ... 5,000.00

For making a record of any fact by this Act or authorised to be recorded by the Registrar ... 5,000.00

## II -- BY A COMPANY NOT HAVING A SHARE CAPITAL

For registration of a company whose number of members as stated in the articles does not exceed 25 ... 50,000.00

For registration of a company whose number of members as stated in the articles exceeds 25 but does not exceed 100 ... 75,000.00

For registration of a company whose number of members as stated in the articles exceeds 100 but is not stated to be unlimited, a fee of Le20,000 with an additional 50 members or less, after the first 100 ... 50,000.00

For registration of a company whose number of members is stated in the articles to be unlimited.

For registration of any increase in the number of members made after the registration of the company in respect of every 50 members, or less than 50 members of that increase ... 5,000.00

Provided that no company shall be liable to pay on the whole a greater fee than Le150,000 in respect of its number of members, taking into account the fee paid on the first registration of the company.

For registration of any existing company, except such companies as are by the Act exempted from payment of fees in respect of registration under the Act, the same fee as is charged for registration of a new company.

For registering any document by the Act required or authorised to be registered or required to be delivered, sent or forwarded to the Registrar, other than the memorandum of the abstract required to be delivered to the Registrar by the liquidator in a winding up in Sierra Leone ... 5,000.00

For making a record of any fact by this Act required or authorised to be recorded by the Registrar ... 5,000.00

**II — BY A COMPANY TO WHICH PART IX OF THE ACT APPLIES**

For registering any document required to be delivered to the Registrar under Part IX of the Act ... 40,000.00”

For registration of a company whose number of members is stated in the articles to be unlimited.

For registration of any increase in the number of members made after the registration of the company in respect of every 50 members, or less than 50 members of that increase ... 5,000.00

Provided that no company shall be liable to pay on the whole a greater fee than Le150,000 in respect of its number of members, taking into account the fee paid on the first registration of the company.

For registration of any existing company, except such companies as are by the Act exempted from payment of fees in respect of registration under the Act, the same fee as is charged for registration of a new company.

For registering any document by the Act required or authorised to be registered or required to be delivered, sent or forwarded to the Registrar, other than the memorandum of the abstract required to be delivered to the Registrar by the liquidator in a winding up in Sierra Leone ... 5,000.00

For making a record of any fact by this Act required or authorised to be recorded by the Registrar ... 5,000.00

**II — BY A COMPANY TO WHICH PART IX OF THE ACT APPLIES**

For registering any document required to be delivered to the Registrar under Part IX of the Act ... 40,000.00”
