The National Reformation Council Decrees (Repeal) Act, 1968 Short title.

[25th July, 1968.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Decrees specified in the first column of the Schedule are hereby repealed and accordingly the provisions of law suspended by the Decrees herein repealed and specified in the second column of the Schedule are hereby restored. Repeal of N.R.C. Decrees.
