THE ALLUVIAL DIAMOND MINING (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1987 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 30 of the Alluvial Diamond Mining Act the President, acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, hereby makes the following rules:—

1. These rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1987. Commencement.

2. The First Schedule to the Alluvial Diamond Mining Rules is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new Schedule:— Replacement of First Schedule to R Vol. VII p. 1770.
