The Public Order (Amendment) Act, 1969

Short title.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 22nd day of November, 1968.

2. Subsection (1) of section 40 of the Public Order Act, 1965 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection--

“(1) Every Regulation made under section 38 and every Order or Rule made in pursuance of such a regulation shall, without prejudice to the validity of anything lawfully done thereunder, cease to have effect at the expiration of a period of four months from the date upon which it came into operation unless, before the expiration of that period, it has been approved by resolution passed by the House of Representatives.”.
