**The Criminal Procedure (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1973** Short title.

[1st November, 1973.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Section 188 of the Criminal Procedure Act, 1965 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

Additional witnesses for prosecution. 188. If a prosecutor is of the opinion that there is in any criminal trial any material or necessary witness other than those listed on the back of the indictment, the prosecutor may call the witness before the trial Court upon giving to the Registrar of the Court and to the accused notice of his intention to do so together with a summary of the evidence to be given by the witness.”

Repeal and replacement of section 188 of Act No. 32 of 1965.

Passed in Parliament this *10th* day of *October*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
