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THE COMMISSIONS OF INQUIRY ACT
(Cap. 54)

THE COMMISSION OF INQUIRY (FORFEITURE OF ASSETS) ORDER, 1993 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (4) of section 7 of the Commissions of Inquiry Act (Cap. 54) the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following Order—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 5th day of February, 1993. Commence-
ment.

2. (1) Each person specified in the first column of the First Schedule in respect of whom the Justice Laura Marcus-Jones Commission of Inquiry has made a report shall pay to the State the amount of money specified in relation to him in the second column of the First Schedule. Persons to
pay money .

(2) Each person shall pay the amount specified at a date not later than the 27th day of February, 1993.

3. The vehicles listed in the first column of the Second Schedule belonging to persons in respect of whom the Justice Laura Marcus-Jones Commission of Inquiry has made a report and who are specified in the second column of the Second Schedule are confiscated to the State. Vehicles to
