THE MINERALS ACT
(Cap. 196)

THE MINERALS (ALLUVIAL GOLD MINING AND MARKETING) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1985 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the President by section 92 of the Minerals Act (Cap 196) and acting in accordance with the advice of the Cabinet, these Rules are hereby made—

1. These Rules shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1985. Commencement.

2. For rule 4 of the Minerals (Alluvial Gold Mining and Marketing) Rules, 1984 (P.N. No. 13 of 1984) in these Rules referred to as the "principal Rules" there is hereby substituted the following new rule— Rule 4 of P. N. No. 13 of 1984 replaced.

"Alluvial gold mining licence fee. 4. The fee for an alluvial gold mining licence shall be Le200.00 if issued for one calendar year and Le100.00 if issued for half a calendar year."

3. For subrule (2) of rule 5 of the principal Rules there is hereby substituted the following new subrule— Rule 5(2) of principal Rules replaced.

"(2) Every holder of an alluvial gold mining licence shall, when exercising the rights under his licence, pay in advance to the Chiefdom Council of the Chiefdom in respect of which the licence was issued, a rent of Le50.00 per calendar year or Le25.00 per half a calendar year".

4. For rule 8 of the principal Rules there is hereby substituted the following new rule— Rule 8 of principal Rules replaced.

"Alluvial gold dealer's licence fee. 8. The fee for a gold dealer's licence shall be as follows—

“(4) The fee for a gold exporter's agents' certificate shall be Le500.00 per annum.”
