An Act to Amend The Interpretation Act, 1961

Act 46 of 1961.

[16th November, 1961.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Act, 1962 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 16th day of November, 1961. Short title and commencement.

2. Section 3 of the Interpretation Act, 1961 (hereinafter called the principal Act) is hereby amended by—
- (a) the substitution in the fourth line of the definition of "Gazette" of the words "in respect of" for the words "in respect to";
 - (b) the substitution in the fourth line of the definition of "the Provinces" of the figures "1951" for the figures "1961".

Amendment
of section 5
of Act 46
of 1961.

3. Section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution in the fourth line of paragraph (a) thereof of the words "act or thing" for the words "act of thing".
