**An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the
Service of Sierra Leone for the Year 1961/62.**

[11th May, 1961.] Date of
commence-
ment.

WHEREAS by the 1961/62 Appropriation Ordinance (No. 6 Ord. No. 6 of 1961,) a sum not exceeding fifteen million two hundred and thirty-three thousand, nine hundred and sixty-three pounds was provided for the service of Sierra Leone for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-one/sixty-two:

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to provide for expenditure from the Consolidated Revenue Fund of a further sum of two hundred and sixty-three thousand, four hundred and sixty-three pounds in excess of the provision in the said Appropriation Ordinance for the several services set forth in the First Schedule hereto.

S. 14 of Ord. No. 2 of 1961. AND WHEREAS Section 14 of the Finance (Control and Management) Ordinance (No. 2 of 1961) provides that any proposals for such expenditure be submitted to a vote of the House by means of a Supplementary Appropriation Bill which shall contain that expenditure under appropriate Heads.

Rule 2 of Part II of Second Schedule of Ord. No. 2 of 1961. AND WHEREAS by virtue of the powers vested in him by Rule 2 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Finance (Control and Management) Ordinance (No. 2 of 1961) the Minister of Finance has by Warrant authorised the issue from the Contingencies Fund of the sums totalling eighty-nine thousand one hundred and fifty pounds under the Heads set out in the Second Schedule hereto, which could not without serious injury to the public interest have been postponed until provision could be made by Supplementary Appropriation Ordinance.

Rule 5 of Part II of Second Schedule of Ord. No. 2 of 1961. AND WHEREAS Rule 5 of Part II of the Second Schedule to the Finance (Control and Management) Ordinance (No. 2 of 1961) provides that all withdrawals from the Fund shall be reported to the House of Representatives at its next ensuing sitting so that the Fund shall be restored to the amount appropriated under Section 18 of the said Ordinance by inclusion of appropriations to it in a Supplementary Appropriations Ordinance.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Legislation of Sierra Leone, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the 1961/62 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 1) Ordinance, 1961.

£263,463 granted for 1961/62.

2. The sum of two hundred and sixty-three thousand four hundred and sixty-three pounds shall be and is hereby granted to Her Majesty the Queen, Her Heirs and Successors for and during the year nineteen hundred and sixty-one/sixty-two to be applied for the several services set forth in the First Schedule.

£263,463 charged on the revenue.

3. The said sum of two hundred and sixty-three thousand four hundred and sixty-three pounds shall be and is hereby declared to be charged upon and made payable from and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-one/sixty-two and the payment thereof shall be taken to begin immediately after the enactment of this Ordinance:

Contingencies Fund payments from date of Warrant.

Provided that in the case of the sums authorised by the Minister of Finance to be issued from the Contingencies Fund the payment thereof shall be taken to begin on the date of the Warrant authorising such payment.

Accountant-General's Authority to pay.

4. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised and required from time to time upon the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance to pay out of the Consolidated Fund for the several services specified in the First Schedule hereto the sum of two hundred and sixty-three thousand four hundred and sixty-three pounds during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and sixty-two.

5. The Accountant-General is also hereby authorised and required upon the Warrant or Order of the Minister of Finance to pay from the Consolidated Revenue Fund into the Contingencies Fund the sum of eighty-nine thousand one hundred and fifty pounds in reimbursement of the withdrawals from the Contingencies Fund set out in the Second Schedule. Reimbursement of Contingencies Fund.
6. The amount from time to time paid for and in respect of the expenditure authorised in Section 2 shall not exceed in gross the sum of two hundred and sixty-three thousand four hundred and sixty-three pounds, during the year ending on the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and sixty-two and any balances remaining unissued at the end of March nineteen hundred and sixty-two shall lapse and shall not be available for making payments in the following year. Balance at 31.3.62. to lapse.
