**The Education (Amendment) Act, 1966**

Short title.

[18th August, 1966.]

Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. Paragraph (b) of section 13 of the Education Act, 1964, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new paragraph—

“(b) control, subject to the approval of the Minister and in accordance with rules made under section 38, the establishment of new primary schools and the extension of existing primary schools, within such area;”.

2. Subsection (1) of section 18 of the principal Act is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(1) From the date of commencement of this Act no person shall establish or open any new school or extend an existing school without the prior written authority of the Minister, or, in the case of a primary school, of the Local Authority for the area or district in which such primary school is situate:

Provided that a Local Authority shall not grant a written authority under this section without the prior approval of the Minister.”.

3. Subsection (3) of section 19 is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new subsection—

“(3) If upon receipt of an application for registration of a school the Minister is of the opinion that any of the conditions mentioned in subsection (3) of section 18 applies to such school, he may refuse to register such school, and, if he so refuses, shall serve upon the proprietor or manager a notice containing full particulars of the grounds of such refusal.”.

4. Subsection (1) of section 22 of the principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the word “school” in the second line thereof of the words “or extend an existing school”.

5. Paragraph (g) of subsection (1) of section 38 is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the word “schools” in the third line thereof of the words “and the extension of existing primary schools”.
