Act No. 16 of 1964.      AND WHEREAS by the 1963/64 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 1964, a sum not exceeding two hundred and ninety-eight thousand, six hundred and ninety-two pounds was provided for the service of Sierra Leone for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three/sixty-four.

Act No. 51 of 1964.      AND WHEREAS by the 1963/64 Supplementary Appropriation (No. 4) Act, 1964, a sum not exceeding eleven thousand, two hundred and nineteen pounds was provided for the service of Sierra Leone for the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three/sixty-four:
