**The Laws (Adaptation) (Amendment) Act, 1973** Short title.

[31st December, 1973.] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. The First Schedule to the Laws (Adaptation) Act, 1972 is hereby amended by replacing the definition of the word "stranger" in paragraph (ii) of Chapter 199 Diamond Industry Protection by the following new definition—

Amendment of First Schedule to Act No. 29 of 1972.

“ “stranger” means a person who is not indigenous to a Diamond Protection Area declared under section 3:

Provided that if any question arises in any proceedings as to whether a person is or is not a Stranger in relation to any particular Diamond Protection Area the burden of proving that such a person is indigenous to that area shall be on that person”.

Passed in Parliament this *12th* day of *December*, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three.
