THE REGISTRATION OF INSTRUMENTS (FEES) ORDER, 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 27 of the Registration of Instruments Act the Minister of Finance hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 2000.

2. The Second Schedule to the Registration of Instruments Act is repealed and replaced by the following Schedule:—
