(Cap. 55)

THE CENSUS (APPOINTMENT OF CENSUS COMMITTEE) ORDER, 1985 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred on the President by paragraph (b) of section 5 of the Census Act (Cap. 55) as amended by the Census (Amendment) Act, 1974 (Act No. 14 of 1974) this Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th day of March, 1985. Commencement.

2. The following persons are hereby appointed to be members of the Census Committee for the purposes of the Census, 1985— Appointment of Census Committee.

- (a) The Census Commissioner, Chairman,
- (b) A representative of the Sierra Leone Trade Union Congress,
- (c) A representative of the Sierra Leone Teachers Union,
- (d) A representative of the Republic of Sierra Leone Military Forces,
- (e) A representative of the Supreme Islamic Council,
- (f) A representative of the United Christian Council,
- (g) A representative of the Conference of Catholic Bishops,
- (h) A representative of the Administrative Secretary of the All People's Congress,
- (i) A representative of the Freetown City Council,
- (j) Paramount Chief Dr. B. S. Kamal, Northern Province,
- (k) Paramount Chief S. M. Koker, Southern Province,
- (l) Paramount Chief B. N. Gbatekaka, Eastern Province.

3. The Administrative Secretary, National Population Census Secretariat shall act as Secretary to the Census Committee. Secretary of Committee.
