The Consolidated Revenue Fund Salaries, Act, 1966 Short title.
Being an Act to Provide for the Salaries of the Governor-General
and certain other Officers

[, 19 .] Date of commencement.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Constitution of Sierra Leone **Preamble.**
that the holders of certain offices shall be paid such salaries as
may be prescribed by law and that the salaries and allowances
payable to the holders of such offices shall be a charge on the
Consolidated Revenue Fund and shall not be altered to the dis-
advantage of any such office holder after his appointment:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to fix the amounts of such salaries and allowances and make provision for the payment thereof by the Accountant-General of Sierra Leone:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Commence-
ment.

1. This Act shall come into operation on such date as the Minister responsible for Judicial matters shall determine by Order published in the *Gazette*.

Amount of
salaries

2. There shall in each financial year be paid out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund without further appropriation than this Act to the holders of the offices set out below the yearly salaries and allowances appearing opposite those offices in the columns headed "Salary" and "Allowances" respectively and *pro rata* for any part of a year—

3. The Accountant-General is hereby authorised to pay the salaries and allowances authorised by section 2 to the holders of the respective offices therein specified in respect of any period during which he is satisfied, by notice in the *Gazette* or otherwise, that the person concerned held any such office.

Saving.

4. Nothing in this Act shall in any way effect the emoluments of the present holder of the office of President of the Court of Appeal.

Repeal.

5. The Consolidated Revenue Fund Salaries Act, 1961, is hereby repealed.
