**The Customs Tariff (Amendment) Act, 1976**

Short title.

[7th September, 1976] Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1. Section 15 of the Customs Tariff Act, 1968, is hereby repealed and replaced by the following new section—

Repeal and replacement of section 15 of Act No. 15 of 1968.

"Interim Order to be confirmed, amended or revoked by Parliament.

15. Every Order made under section 14 shall, within twenty-one days from the first day of the next session of Parliament after its publication or if Parliament is in session within twenty-one days of its publication, be submitted to Parliament and Parliament may by resolution confirm, amend or revoke such Order, and upon publication of such resolution in the *Gazette* the resolution shall have effect and the said Order shall then expire. If the Order be not submitted within the said twenty-one days to Parliament for confirmation it shall *ipso facto* expire."

Passed in Parliament this 19th day of *August* in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-six.
