**Sierra Leone**

**An Act to Amend the Tribal Administration (Western Area) Act** Cap. 78.

[ 1st January, 1933. Date of commencement.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the House of Representatives in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Tribal Administration (Western Area) (Amendment) Act, 1964 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, 1933, and any act or thing done or omitted or proceedings taken under any rules purported to have been made under the Tribal Administration (Western Area) Act (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act) or any Act amending the same which would have been validly done or omitted or taken under the principal Act shall be deemed to be and to have been validly and properly done or omitted or taken thereunder. Short title, commencement of and validation of things purported to have been done under principal Act. Cap. 78

2. Subsection (2) of section 5 of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) by the substitution for the figure “13” in the fifth line thereof of the figure “14”; and
- (b) by the insertion immediately after the word “tribe” in the sixth line thereof of the words “or area”.
