THE NON-CITIZENS (TRADE AND BUSINESS) ACT, 1969
(Act No. 9 of 1969)

THE NON-CITIZENS (TRADE AND BUSINESS) (FEES) ORDER, 1993 Short title.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section 6 of the Non-Citizens (Trade and Business) Act, 1969 as adapted by paragraph 5 of the Proclamation entitled "The Administration of Sierra Leone (National Provisional Ruling Council) Proclamation, 1992", the National Provisional Ruling Council makes the following order—

1. This order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1992. Commencement.
2. The fees payable on the issue and renewal, extension or transfer of registration certificates under the provisions of section 3 of the Non-Citizens (Trade and Business) Act, 1969 shall be as set out in the Schedule below— Fees.
